Flood Relief

>> Folks around Mary Brickell Village will be happy to know that the City of Miami has committed up to \$3 million for drainage, street resurfacing and beautification improvements. The city received numerous complaints about these streets from area stakeholders, said Ola Aluko, director of the office of Capital Improvements and Transportation.

The upcoming issuance of a second series of street bonds includes the amount to address the Mary Brickell Village flooding.

Preliminary design work on the 9th and 10th Street drainage system is underway. Other drainage improvements, milling, resurfacing and landscaping will be proposed for the general area. Aluko said his office will meet with the Downtown Development Authority to further define the scope of work.

The project is expected to begin in late spring or early summer of 2010.
